Ms Keneally will speak about the impact of faith on political decisions. As a theologian and a former politician she posits that no sensible solution to some of the most vexed societal questions – whether on national security or marriage equality – can be derived and resolved without understanding and respecting the religious dimensions of human actions.

The Hon Kristina Keneally is the 42nd Premier of New South Wales (2009 – 2011) and was a Member of the Parliament of New South Wales from 2003 – 2012. Ms Keneally is the Director of Gender Inclusion and Adjunct Professor at Macquarie Graduate School of Management and an Anchor at Sky News Australia. She holds a Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in Political Science and a Master of Arts in Religious Studies from the University of Dayton in Ohio. She has published many articles in academic and popular journals on religion, politics and feminism.
